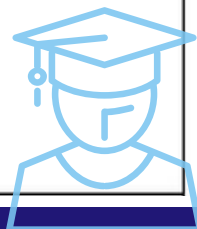

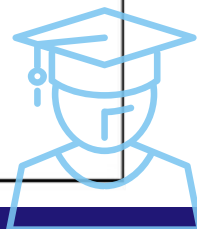

<p><b>Scholarship for The Arc New York Chapter Employees</b></p>	<p>Four \$3,000 scholarships are presented annually to full time Chapter employees who wish to further their education with the intention of contributing to the field of intellectual or developmental disabilities. The scholarship is paid in installments of \$1,500.00 per semester for any year the student is enrolled in college. <p><b>Peggy Jo Power Gifford Scholarship</b></p> <p>Daughter of the American Revolution</p>	<p>One \$500 scholarship presented annually. The object of the Peggy Jo Power Giffard Scholarship is to financially assist deserving young people in acquiring a higher education in United States History or Philanthropy with a view to becoming better prepared for life and citizenship.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any individual interested in majoring in United States History, Philanthropic Studies or NonProfit Management is eligible.</li> <li>• An application should be submitted to either the Regent or Scholarship Chairman of the sponsoring DAR Chapter.</li> <li>• The applicant is to be judged on the basis of merit and achievement with regard to community service, personal and academic interests.</li> <li>• The applicant must reside in New York State.</li> <li>• The applicant must be attending or applying to attend an accredited two or four year college or university in the United States.</li> <li>• All applications must be received by the sponsoring Chapter Chairman by <b>JANUARY 15th</b></li> <li>• The sponsoring chapter may sponsor only <b>ONE</b> student.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Monday, January 15, 2024</b></p> <p><a href="#">Peggy Jo Scholarship Application</a></p>

Each year the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) awards multiple scholarships to students showing dedication to the pursuit of higher education in diverse areas of study including history, economics, law, political science, medicine, nursing, occupational and physical therapy, elementary and secondary education, chemistry, math, science and English.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All FEMALES who have successfully completed their high school studies are eligible.</li> <li>• The applicant MUST be a resident of New York State and have been born in the United States.</li> <li>• The applicant MUST attend an accredited four year college or university.</li> <li>• In the event that the scholarship recipient should successfully acquire a college degree in less than four years and is continuing graduate studies, they may request the remainder of the award from the State Scholarship Chairman.</li> <li>• All applications must be received by the sponsoring Chapter Chairman by <b>JANUARY 15th</b></li> <li>• The sponsoring chapter may sponsor only ONE student.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Wednesday, January 31, 2024</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><a href="#"><u>Helen and Arnold Barben Scholarship Application</u></a></p>

The object of the New York State  
DAR Scholarship is to financially  
assist deserving high school seniors  
in acquiring a higher education in a  
college or university in New York  
State.

- A student in the upper fourth of the graduating class is to be selected by a committee consisting of the principal, Guidance Counselor and English Department Head. If there is more than one high school in the area, each school may name only ONE student and the local DAR Chapter area. The Chapter Chairman submits only ONE student from all the applicants from the school in her area. The Chapter Chairman submits only ONE entry per scholarship.
- The applicant MUST be a resident of New York State and a United States Citizen.
- The applicant must plan to attend an accredited four year college or university in New York State.
- In the event that the scholarship recipient does not complete his/her program or successfully acquires his/her degree in less than four years, the scholarship shall be terminated and the runner-up candidate for that year will be eligible to receive the balance of the scholarship.
