<p>MMB Accounting Diversity Scholarship</p>	<p>The MMB Accounting Diversity Scholarship was created to provide financial assistance to minority students seeking to pursue a career in accounting, as this field has been historically underrepresented by the minority community. We want to help change those statistics and help students work towards their dreams.</p> <p>MMB will award two, annually renewable \$2,000 per-year scholarships, as well as an opportunity to receive a paid accounting internship during the student's junior or senior year of college. The scholarship can be renewed up to five years, with a maximum total award of \$10,000 per recipient.</p>	<p>Student must identify with an ethnic minority - Student must have applied to, or currently attend a college in NYS offering accounting programs that will ultimately lead the student to licensure as a certified public accountant CPA (only students studying full-time at a school in NYS are eligible for the scholarship.
