# MMB Accounting Diversity Scholarship

The MMB Accounting Diversity
Scholarship was created to
provide financial assistance to
minority students seeking to
pursue a career in accounting, as
this field has been historically
underrepresented by the minority
community. We want to help
change those statistics and help
students work towards their
dreams.

MMB will award two, annually renewable \$2,000 per-year scholarships, as well as an opportunity to receive a paid accounting internship during the student's junior or senior year of college. The scholarship can be renewed up to five years, with a maximum total award of \$10,000 per recipient.

Student must identify with an ethnic minority - Student must have applied to, or currently attend a college in NYS offering accounting programs that will ultimately lead the student to licensure as a certified public accountant CPA (only students studying full-time at a school in NYS are eligible for the scholarship. If a student awarded a scholarship chooses not to study full-time in NYS, the scholarship will be forfeited.) -Students must have

anything besides accounting, the scholarship will be forfeited.)
