<b>The Hagan Scholarship</b>	<p>The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide need-based merit scholarship, providing recipients with the opportunity to achieve their goals and graduate college debt-free. Applicants must graduate from a high school located in the United States. Applicant's Adjusted Gross Household Income reported for 2022 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$100,000. Free workshops, Free Schwab Brokerage Accounts, and Free Study Abroad provide recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum. The intended recipient is a high-achieving goal-driven student having substantial financial need.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Must be a U.S. Citizen or have a Permanent Resident Card (Green Card).</li> <li>2. Must attend a high school located in the United States. Can be a public, private, charter, magnet, or STEM school.</li> <li>3. Must be in the high school graduating class.</li> <li>4. Must have achieved a 3.50 Cumulative Grade Point Average.</li> <li>5. Must enroll in an eligible four-year not-for-profit College or University the first semester following high school graduation.</li> <li>6. Must maintain a four year or less graduation schedule in <u>college</u>, or complete the equivalent of a four year degree if in a professional program.</li> <li>7. Recipients must work 240 hours from January 1, <u>2024</u> until commencement of the 2024 fall semester in college. Work can be performed at <u>recipient</u> discretion. Employment must be regularly scheduled work performed under supervision for compensation. Work can be full-time during the summer and/or part-time work.</li> <li>8. Applicant's Adjusted Gross Household Income reported for 2022 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$100,000. "Household Income" is defined as the total income received by all members of a household living under the same roof.</li> <li>9. Applicants selected as Finalists must provide a copy of their FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS).</li> <li>10. Must apply for Federal and State grants if eligible.</li> <li>11. <p><b>Make All the Difference Scholarship</b></p>	<p>Make All The Difference Scholarships and Awards recognize students for whom alternative education has made all the difference. Scholarships reimburse recipients for expenses related to post-secondary education or training and are for a maximum of \$5,000. Up to 50% of the total scholarship is available per semester. The amount of a scholarship for any one student must be used within two years.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The recipient's status as a continuously enrolled student in the post-secondary program for which the scholarship was awarded. Scholarship disbursements may be adjusted based on enrollment status.</li> <li>• The recipient's demonstrating that he/she is using the funds appropriately for eligible expenses for which the scholarship is intended.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Friday, March 1, 2024</b></p> <p><a href="#"><u>Make All the Difference Scholarship</u></a></p>
