

Personalized Parking Space for Seniors only!

REQUIREMENTS & DESIGN REQUEST Form.

Requirements to paint your parking space:

- Senior student must have a valid parking permit.
- Pay a refundable \$20 deposit. The parking space needs to return to a solid black space at the end of the school year. The student is responsible to paint this space. Materials will be provided. Dates TBD.
- The attached Design Request Form must be turned into the main office by September 29th at 3:00 pm.
- The parking space is yours to park in Monday-Friday 7:00am-3:00 pm.
- Parking spaces are reserved on a first come first served basis.
- Students must purchase their own paint and supplies.
- Students can only paint during the designated days/times, TBD.
- Students can only reserve one space.

Materials needed to paint your parking space.

- Latex paint – Exterior – Water based.
- NO oil-based, NO reflective paint.
- Brushes, rollers, and/or sponges to apply the paint.
- Masking tape to mark off 12” border from the yellow/white lines.
- Broom to sweep space prior to painted and for clean up.
- Drop cloth to put under paint cans, materials.
- Containers to hold dirty brushes, sponges, materials, etc.
- Water for clean up.

Optional materials

- Chalk to sketch your design prior to painting.
- Sunscreen, hats, sunglasses, snacks, water, pop-up tent, etc.

Design Criteria

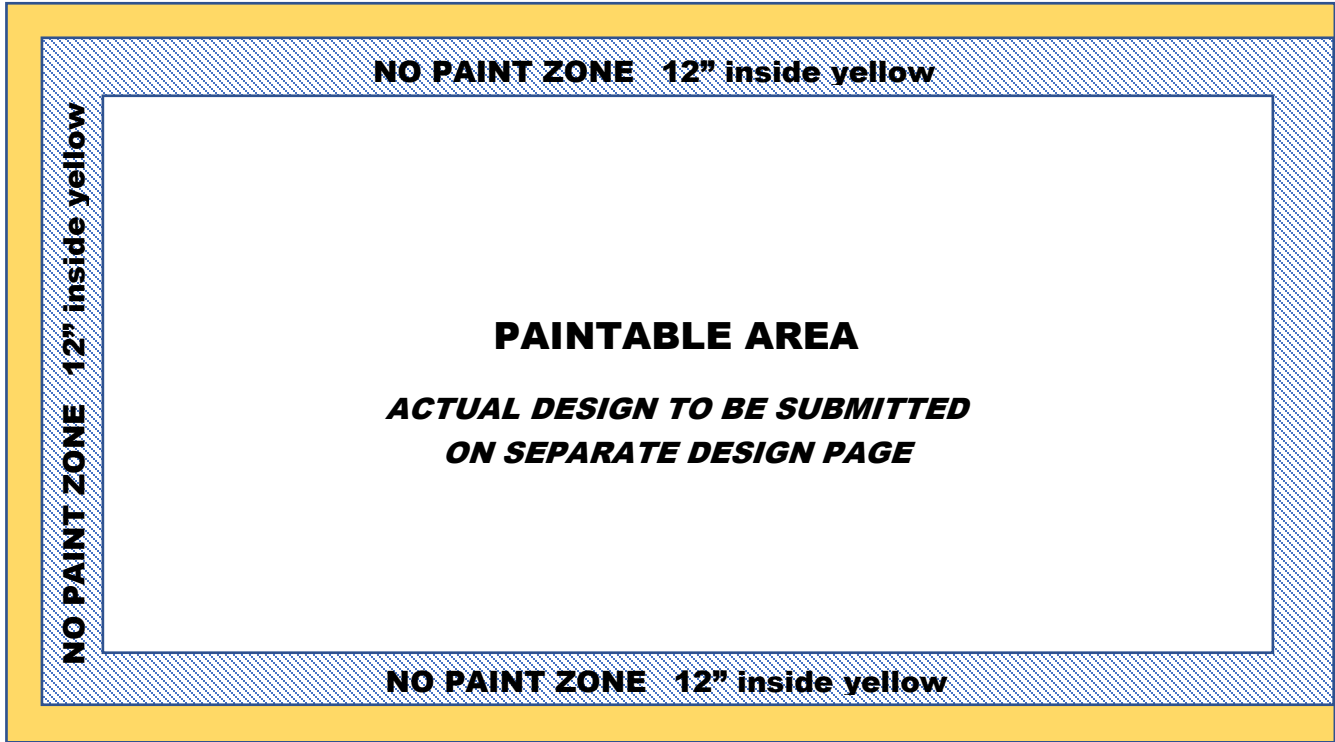
- No offensive language, images, innuendos.
- No gang symbols, references.
- No double meanings, entendre.
- No names, real or fictitious, etc. Your name is acceptable (no nickname)
- Design Request Form and sketch must be submitted by September 29 at 3:00 pm.
- If approved, painting cannot deviate from sketch. If it does it must be corrected at student’s expense.
- Prohibited content/materials will be covered over at the discretion of administration and at the student’s expense. Disciplinary action may be taken.

Painting Tips:

- Tape the edges of your spot with a 12” margin before painting.
- Do not paint on the yellow (or white) stripes.
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles off of your parking space before you paint.
- Use chalk to sketch your design
- Start painting from front to back (bumper to bumper), others may be working on spaces next to you.
- Consider making a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images (saves a lot of time).

- Bring water, paper towels, containers, and plastic bags for cleaning purposes.
- No painting outside of your Parking Space.
- Paint can be expensive; consider sharing with others especially if you intend to use multiple colors.
- An estimated 2 quarts of paint is necessary to cover the entire space.
- Bring a pop-up tent to stay out of the hot sun.

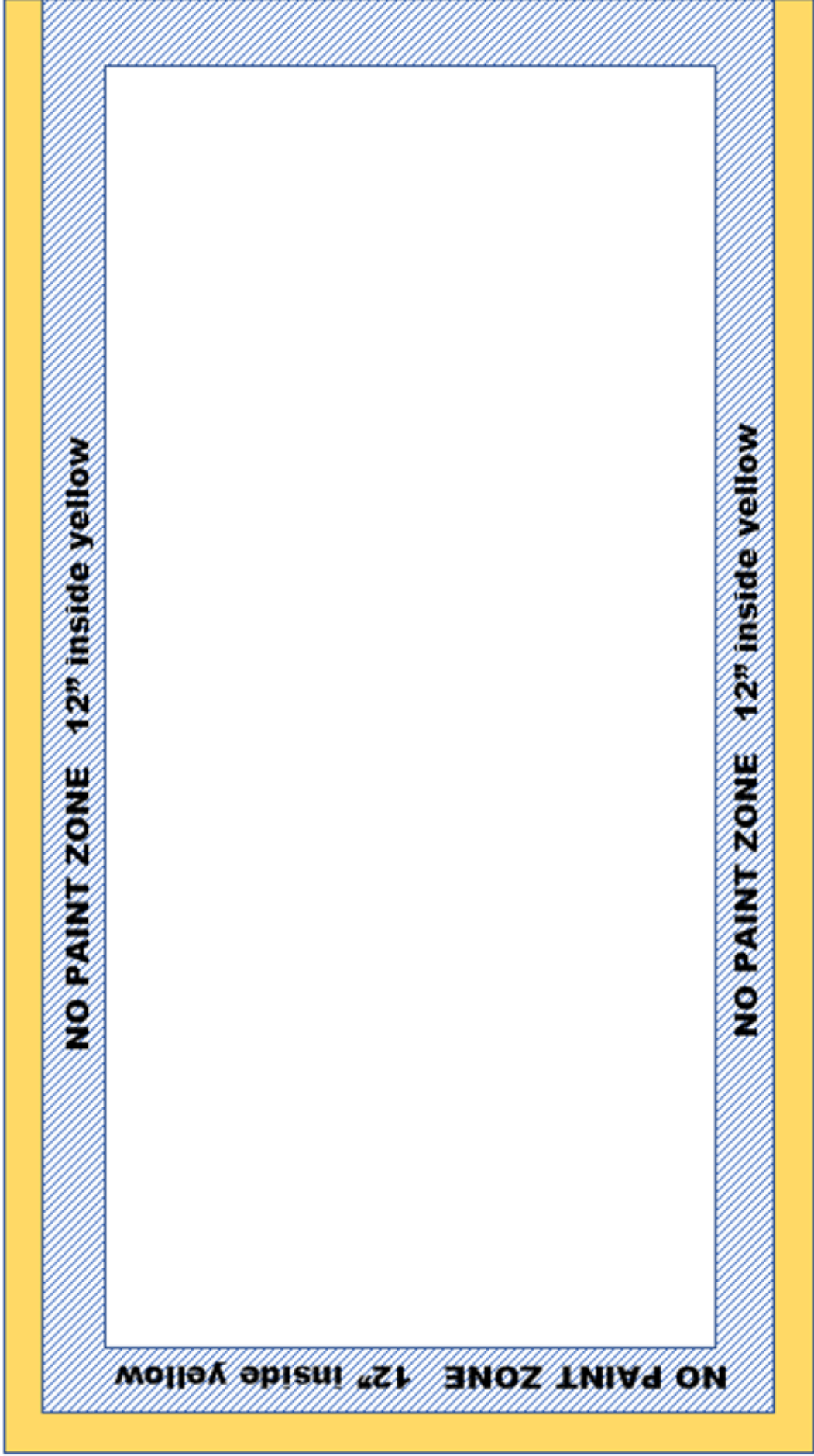
