- > New York State Education Department (NYSED) Accountability Update
 - NYS 3-8 Assessments were discussed (i.e., 30 assessments in Math and ELA make up a subgroup 15 students per grade level)
 - We are a targeted district based on the English Language Learners (ELL) subgroup performance for two straight years at OMS.
 - Led by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) accountability movement.
 - To align with the New York State Education Department's (NYSED) School Comprehensive Education Plan (SCEP) and District Comprehensive Improvement Plan (DCIP) processes, the following steps should be integrated for ELL:
 - 1. Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA)
 - 2. Goal Setting and Action Planning
 - 3. Professional Development (PD) Planning
 - 4. Curriculum and Instructional Alignment
 - 5. Intervention Implementation
 - 6. Family and Community Engagement Planning
 - 7. Data Analysis and Monitoring
 - 8. Collaborative Review and Reporting
- > Brockport Smart Scholars Early College High School (BECHS) Program Update
 - Up to 25 high School students could earn 24-60 college credits completely covered by the BECHS grant.
 - Partnership between BCSD and MCC, SUNY Brockport, and LevaCloud to offer college-level educational opportunities towards a career in Cyber Security.
 - Career networking and mentoring opportunities that give students a head start to posthigh school education.
