Our office must receive your registration form** and payment one week prior to the first day of class/ session unless a specific deadline is noted. Please remember that prompt registration may reduce the likelihood of classes being cancelled due to low enrollment. You must be 18 years old or older to be eligible to register, except for courses designed specifically for younger participants.

Refunds, Cancellations & Confirmation:

Refunds are provided only if a student withdraws from the class 24 hours before the scheduled start date. No refunds will be provided after the first class. If you join a class after the scheduled start date, the tuition will be the same amount. If a class needs to be cancelled due to maintenance or weather emergencies, no partial refund will be issued. Refunds will be processed for courses that have been fully cancelled from our schedule for reasons such as low enrollment. Fees for registration do not include the cost of books, materials, or supplies, unless noted.

Cancelled classes will be rescheduled whenever possible. If a class is not able to be rescheduled and is part of a series, no refund will be given. If a one-time only class is cancelled due to weather or emergency and not able to be rescheduled, a refund may be offered. No continuing education classes are held when Brockport schools are closed due to weather cancellations or emergency conditions. If you do not receive a notification of cancellation, your class will be held. No confirmations are sent.

Effective February 2023, NYS laws went into effect that now allow for electronic notarizations. You may not perform electronic notarizations unless you have registered capabilities to do so with the State of New York. This class will train you in what you need to know to become an Electronic Notary in New York State. You will learn the policies, procedures and software requirements that are mandated by the state for electronic notarizations. Only electronic procedures are covered in this class. To register for this class, you must be 18 years or older, a current Notary Public or have taken the traditional Becoming a Notary Public class. Safety Training

Red Cross CPR/AED Certification

This Adult CPR/AED blended learning course equips students to recognize and care for various breathing and cardiac emergencies involving adults. It is designed for students who need a certification that satisfies OSHA workplace or other regulatory requirements. This class is taught in a blended learning format and the online portion (accessed via mobile desktop or tablet) must be completed prior to attending the instructor-led skills session. Upon successful completion a valid 2-year digital certificate for Adult CPR/AED is issued. Participants must complete both the online and classroom portions of the program to earn certification. A link for the online portion will be sent to participants after registration is received.

Red Cross Lifeguard Certification Course

This course Provides entry-level participants the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies such as injuries, sudden illness, breathing or cardiac emergencies. Participants must be at least 15 years old and be able to complete a timed event within 1 minute 40 and seconds by starting in the water, swimming 20 yards, surface diving to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object. Then return to the surface and swim 20 yards on their back to return to the starting point and exit the water without using steps or a ladder. They must also be able to swim 300 yards continuously and tread water for 2 minutes using only their legs. Participants who successfully complete this Lifequarding course will receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED which will be valid for 2 years. For more details on the six times this 3-day course will be offered, please see the information below. Participants must complete all 16 hours of pool and classroom time to earn certification.

Participants who successfully complete this recertification course will receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED which will be valid for 2 years.
