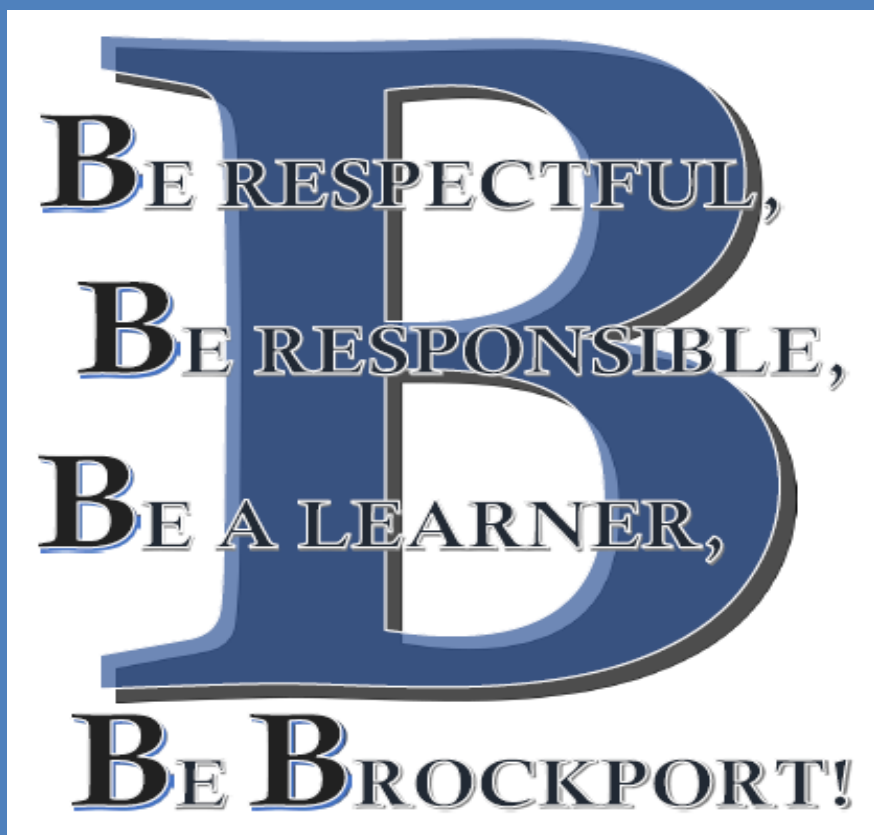

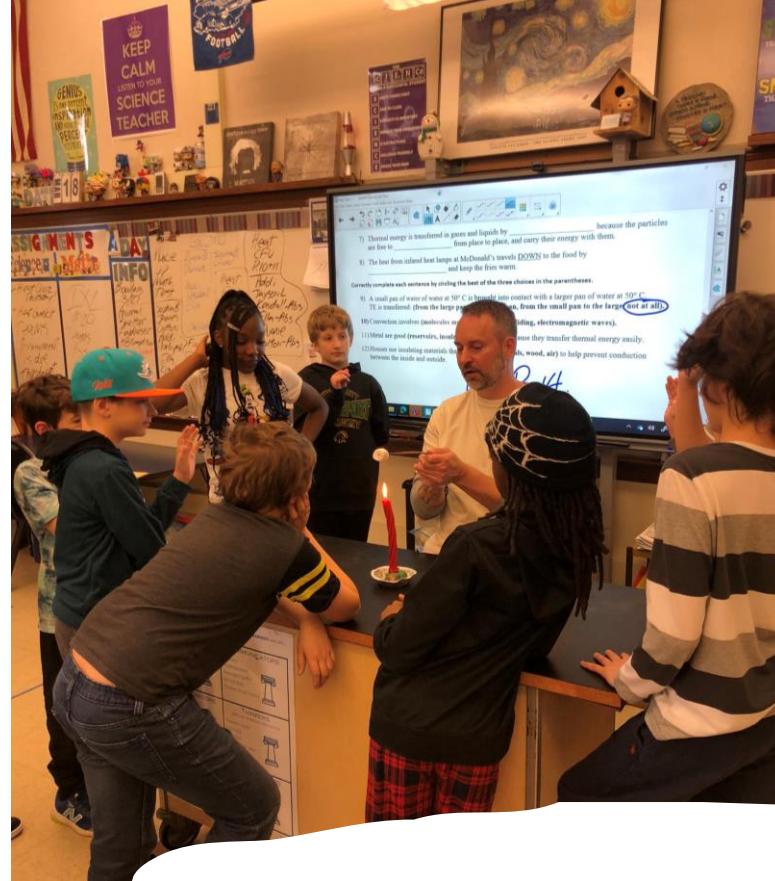

They will grab breakfast in the cafeteria and go directly to class

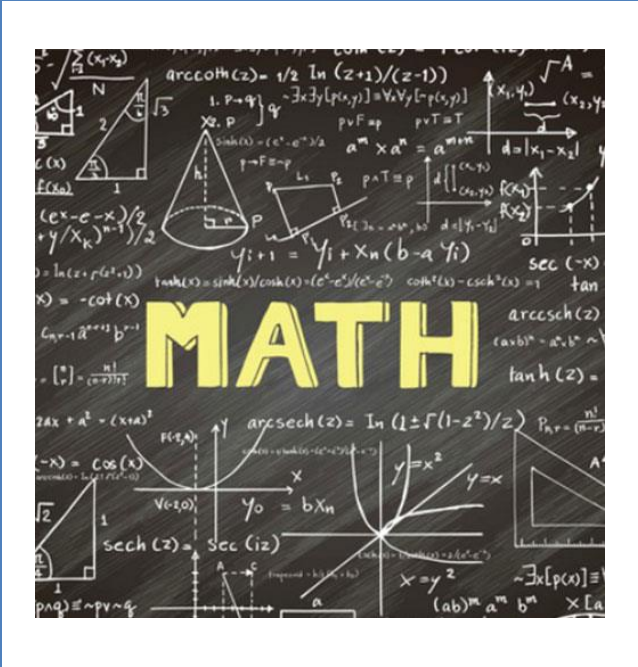
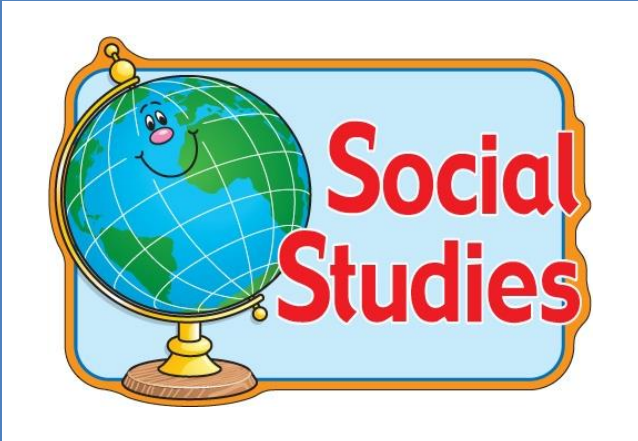
Students are given time in homebase to eat their breakfast
